

## Purpose of this Manual

The purpose of this manual is to provide you with an opportunity to become familiar with the AMEDD Individual Medical Readiness Tracking Module.

The Medical Operational Data System (MODS) resides on the NISA Mainframe platform located at the Pentagon. MODS, along with all of its stored data, resides in a central repository at the Pentagon instead of on your local computer's hard drive. All MODS users worldwide can have access to the very same data at the very same time. This allows MODS to function as a true real-time system. This means that data entered from any site in the world can be viewed by any other authorized person regardless of where they are located in the world or when they want to view the data. This gives the AMEDD a true view of AMEDD Readiness status.

This manual will provide you with an orientation to the following:

- ◆ Utilizing MODS Function Keys and Quick Navigation Commands
- ◆ Accessing the MEDPROS Individual Medical Readiness Module
- ◆ Inputting individual medical readiness data on a specific individual or unit
- ◆ Updating and editing existing on-line individual medical readiness records
- ◆ Generating unit medical readiness status reports

## Training Scenario

The following page contains all of the information you will need to practice using the Individual Medical Readiness Module. You will be able to logon to MODS and input training medical readiness data on a real unit.

The Immunization information that feeds the individual and unit medical readiness reports is fed from the MEDPROS Immunization Tracking Main Menu (FRM). Those procedures are outlined in a separate manual for the MEDPROS Immunization Tracking Module.

Please follow the training scenario provided and use only the information on Page 5. You will be inputting data into the **ATRSDEV** region, which is the training region for MODS. The UIC's provided on Page 5 have been set aside for training.

***It is critical that we do not contaminate actual soldier's medical readiness records.***

## MODS Hands-On Training Exercise Team-00

### Instructions:

(WARNING - DO NOT ENTER DATA INTO DB2 SURGEON GENERAL MODS, USE THE ATRSDEV REGION ONLY!)

Break down class into training teams. One person operates the computer while other team members provide guidance and instructions using the manuals for reference. Team members take turns on the computer. One training logon ID is assigned to each training team.

### Scenario:

Your Commander or command medical authority has directed that individual medical readiness records be updated for the units whose UIC's are provided by the instructor. Some medical readiness data may be posted utilizing unit updates, while other data elements will be updated on individual medical readiness records.

- ◆ Medical Nondeployable Profiles (Unit Update)
- ◆ Occupational Protection Hearing (Unit Update)
- ◆ Pregnancy (Individual Update) or
- ◆ Medical Warning Tags (Individual Update)



- ◆ Run a Unit Medical Readiness Status Report for the training unit.
- ◆ When roster is completed, update medical readiness data for the unit.
- ◆ Drill down to individual records and verify entries.
- ◆ Print roster and one report if printer is available.
- ◆ Download dataset, print using ASMPRINT and MS Word.
- ◆ Run a new Unit Medical Readiness Status Report, view online.

# Navigational Hints

In order to help you maneuver around MODS quickly and efficiently, we have put together a few pointers. For a complete listing of MODS FUNCTION KEYS and QUICK NAVIGATION COMMANDS, refer to Chapter 5 of the *Supplemental Manual*.



*MODS Main Menu System Option Panel (SOP)*

This menu panel is an example of the different ways to select a menu item. The **MODS MAIN MENU** is called the SYSTEM OPTION PANEL (SOP). The UNIQUE PANEL IDENTIFIER can be located at the top of the screen in parentheses (i.e. SOP). They are also listed on the many MODS menus just to the left of the menu title. You can select MODS sub-menus by:


- ◆ pressing <TAB> to advance the cursor to the underscore located to the left of the menu item, typing "S" and pressing <ENTER>
- ◆ or using the quick navigational UNIQUE PANEL IDENTIFIER located between the left underscore and the sub-menu item title (i.e. FMM) in conjunction with the equal (=) sign

At the COMMAND PROMPT, simply type "=FMM", then press <ENTER> to proceed directly to the MEDPROS Main Menu (FMM). You can do this from anywhere within MODS.

***COMMAND ==> =FMM, then press <ENTER>***

You can bypass several MODS menus by using this technique.

### MODS Main Menu System Option Panel (SOP)

Aside from using the two methods mentioned on the previous page, you can also navigate around MODS using the function keys located on your keyboard as well as using your mouse.


MODS FUNCTION KEYS are located at the bottom of each panel. These FUNCTION KEYS are dynamic and only appear on the panel if they perform a function on that panel. Several FUNCTION KEYS perform the same function, regardless of which panel they appear on. For example:

- ◆ PF1 is always HELP. HELP text will appear specifically for that panel.
- ◆ PF2 will always return you to the MODS System Option Panel (SOP).
- ◆ PF3 always returns you to the previous panel.
- ◆ PF7 is always <PAGE UP>, backing you up one page at a time.
- ◆ PF8 is always <PAGE DOWN>, advancing you forward one page at a time.
- ◆ PF10 is always <PAGE LEFT>, advancing you to the left one page at a time.
- ◆ PF11 is always <PAGE RIGHT> advancing you to the right one page at a time.

You can also use your mouse to click on the FUNCTION TAB located at the bottom of the QWS3270 Dialogue Screen.




*MODS Main Menu System Option Panel (SOP)*

The MODS MAIN MENU is called the SYSTEM OPTION PANEL (SOP). You can select MODS sub-menus by either <TABBING> to the underscore, typing “S” and pressing <ENTER> or using the quick navigational UNIQUE PANEL IDENTIFIER located between the left underscore and the sub-menu item title (i.e. FMM) in conjunction with the equal (=) sign. Expand your menu by pressing <F6> or clicking <PF6>.

***To select the “MEDPROS MAIN MENU (FMM)”,  
simply type “=FMM” at the command prompt, then press <ENTER>.***


*Medical Protection System (MEDPROS) Main Menu (FMM)*

Medical Protection System (MEDPROS) main menu (FMM) lists the sub-menus that are available within the MEDPROS module. To select the MEDICAL READINESS MAIN MENU (FTM), either <TAB> to the underscore, type “S” and press <ENTER> or use the quick navigational UNIQUE PANEL IDENTIFIER by typing =FTM on the Command line, then press <ENTER>.




*Medical Readiness Main Menu (FTM)*

Running one of the Medical Readiness Rosters is your first step in determining your unit’s or an individual’s readiness status – but you need to tell the system which immunization and readiness profiles you want to measure their status against. If you cannot remember the name of the Profile(s) you want to use (or if you just want to select from a list to avoid typing them on the FTM menu), the Select Immunization/Medical Readiness Profiles option (FTB) allows you to select from a list of all System Immunization and Medical Profiles, as well as any Individual Profiles you may have created. You will not be able to view Individual Profiles created by other Logon IDs.

**<TAB> to the underscore to the left of FTB, Select Immunization/Medical Readiness Profiles, type an “S” to select and press <ENTER>.**

*Select Immunization/Medical Readiness Profiles (FTB)*

Immunization Profiles are listed on the left side of this screen and Medical Profiles are listed on the right side. The remainder of the system immunization profiles are listed on page 2 (F8 will page down). You can only select one of each of these profiles to use with the options on the Medical Readiness Main Menu (FTM) screen. To select a profile, type an “S” on the underscore to the left of the immunization and/or medical profiles you wish to use, then press the F5 key to post them to the FTM screen.

**<TAB> to the underscore to the left of the immunization and/or medical profiles you want to use and type an “S”, then press the F5 key to post them to the Medical Readiness Main Menu (FTM) screen.**

The FTM Screen will appear with the profiles you selected entered in the appropriate fields. At this point, you can complete the FTM Screen by entering a UIC, Task Force Name, or SSN and selecting the option you want from the menu on the bottom portion of the screen.

You cannot create or modify profiles using the FTB option. It exists only for your convenience in selecting Immunization and/or Medical profiles to use with the other options on the screen. Creating/Updating Profiles (FTV) will be covered in the next chapter.

***Type “=FTM ” to return to a cleared FTM Menu.***

To view the country codes go to your System Option Panel, select Verification Table Menu. On the Verification Table Menu, select the TAPDB Table Listings. Once on the TAPDB Table Selection screen, page down (press <F8>) to get to the Country table and select that by putting an “S” on the underscore and pressing <ENTER>. The listing is also in Appendix D – MEDPROS Country Codes, located in the back of this manual.

**NOTE: Not all the medical readiness profiles require a country and operation code. Those that do will have the requirement for a pre and post deployment checklist.**


### System Profiles: Immunization and Medical

**Immunization System Profiles** are designed to serve as a template for the immunizations required for soldiers who have completed Initial Entry Training (Routine Adult) and those required for deployment to the other regions of the world as defined by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Users may not modify System profiles, but they may import them into “Individual” profiles, then add or subtract immunizations to meet the anticipated medical threat as directed by the command medical authority. The MEDPROS Immunization Tracking manual covers this topic in detail.

**Medical System Profiles** were designed primarily to serve as templates for the medical readiness requirements for each Army component (Active Army, National Guard, and Army Reserves). Each component has specific medical profiles created for deployment and readiness, indicated by a “D” or “R” after the component name. These profiles address a maximum of twenty (20) medical readiness indicators identified by a DOD Tri-Service committee as critical for measuring medical readiness of a unit or individual. The major difference between the deployment and readiness profiles is the timeframe used to measure the last HIV test, which differs significantly for deployment (six months – all components) and readiness (two years Active Army & AGRs, five years for National Guard & Army Reserve). In addition, the Reserve Components have an annual requirement for a Current Medical Assessment (CMA), which is not required for active Army soldiers.

Users have the capability of creating their own **Individual Medical Readiness profiles**. They can do this by creating a name for their profile, then selecting one or more of the twenty medical readiness indicators listed in MEDPROS. A user may use one of the System Medical Profiles as a starting point. They can “import” that profile into their Individual profile, then modify it to meet their needs. For example, if the command medical authority wants to add Sickle Cell Screening (SCS) to the indicators in the National Guard D Profile, they can import that system profile into their Individual Profile, and add the Sickle Cell requirement.

### Create/Update Medical Readiness Profiles (FTV)

To create an Individual Medical profile, enter a profile name (perhaps descriptive of its purpose), then select Create/Update Medical Readiness Profiles (FTV) from the FTM Menu.

Profile names can be whatever you want them to be, however, we recommend names that will easily be identified when you use them later for printing pre-screening rosters and checking the readiness status of you unit. Some examples follow:

- ◆ Training# – Used for MEDPROS Training Courses (NOTE: Each student will use their own assigned LOGON ID #)
- ◆ 29<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division D – Used in conjunction with a unit roster to determine who needs what Medical Readiness requirements to be fully deployable

**<TAB> to MED PROFILE, type “Training#” for your profile.  
 <TAB> to the underscore to the left of FTV, type an “S” to select  
 and press <ENTER>.**



*Create/Update Medical Readiness Profiles (FTV)*

The default screen appears with no medical readiness indicators selected, but all listed on two separate pages (press F8/F7 to page down, then up to view all of these requirements). The default business rules show the deployment requirement for HIV testing (180 days). You can see that the only indicators that will make an individual ‘Red’ for deployment are Pregnancy and Medical Non-Deployable Profiles. While other indicators are required prior to deployment, they may be corrected in a relatively short period of time. Therefore not being current will only cause a soldier to be shown as ‘Amber’, indicating a shortcoming that may require some type of resource. To keep from having to select each of these readiness indicators from the list of 20, you can ‘copy’ a system profile by typing ‘COPY’ at the Command Line and pressing the <ENTER> key.

***Type ‘COPY’ at the Command Line and press <ENTER>.***

A pop-up box appears on top of the medical readiness indicators where you may enter the name of an existing System Profile or Individual Profile to copy into the profile you are creating, thus eliminating the need to select each of those indicators individually. In our example, we are going to copy the Department of Defense (DOD) system profile into our Training# profile, then modify it to meet our specific needs.

<TAB> to the SERIES NAME and type “DOD Profile”, then <TAB> to SERIES TYPE and enter “S” (for System Profile) and press <ENTER>. If you were copying one of your Individual Profiles to this new profile, you would also need to tab to the Owner LID and type in your MODS Logon ID (i.e. SJMXX).

***Type “DOD Profile” in SERIES NAME, <TAB> to SERIES TYPE and type “S”, then press <ENTER>.***



When you copy a System or Individual Profile to a new profile, the medical readiness indicators that comprise that profile are activated (indicated by the color change).

In this example, you can see that all of the DOD Profile indicators are active in your individual profile. To see the remaining indicators you need to page down by pressing F8.



Sickle Cell Screening is not a current requirement for Army personnel so we will “delete” this indicator from our list. However, we will “add” Current Medical Assessment” to our profile.



There may be times you want to create a profile to measure only one of the medical readiness indicators, such as DNA, to determine who needs that one requirement and plan for the resources needed to meet it. This exercise will create a profile for just one medical readiness requirement, which we will use later to create a roster of personnel who do not meet the requirement. This will be an individual profile, so you will leave the TYPE code as its default value of “I” designating it as an individual profile.

***<TAB> to MED PROFILE and type “DNA”. <TAB> to the underscore to the left of Create/Update Medical Readiness Profiles (FTV) and type “S” to select, then press <ENTER>.***



Once again, the two-page list of twenty (20) medical readiness indicators appears. Rather than copy a system profile into our DNA Profile, we simply select DNA as the indicator we want to ADD to our profile by typing an “A” on the underscore to its left, pressing the <HOME> key and typing a “U” at the Command Line, and pressing the <ENTER> key.

**<TAB> to the underscore to the left of DNA and type the letter “A”. Press the <HOME> key to return to the Command Line, type the letter “U” to update and then press <ENTER>.**





The multiple Y (Yes), N (No), and NA (Not Applicable) descriptions shown here keep the number of entries you have to remember to a minimum and the medical readiness ratings simple.


A “Y” entry may indicate that a condition exists (i.e. Pregnancy), a test/item is current (i.e. Pap Smear), or that an item that is required is on hand (i.e. 2 Pair of Glasses, One Pair of Mask Inserts). An “N” entry indicates that a condition does not exist (i.e. an Allergy), a test/item is not current (i.e. Medical Assessment), or that a required item is not on hand (i.e. Occupational Protection for Hearing). An “NA” entry indicates that the condition, test/item, or requirement is not applicable for that particular soldier (i.e. use “NA” in the fields for eyeglasses for those personnel who do not need them).

For a more complete description (minus the abbreviations) of each description, press the F1 (HELP) KEY or see Appendix A in this manual.

### *Medical Readiness Main Menu (FTM)*

There are twenty (20) medical readiness indicators in MEDPROS that you will use to measure an individual's or a unit's medical readiness. When you access unit rosters that compare the status of assigned soldiers to the medical readiness requirements, the roster that appears will have a three-letter code for each of the medical readiness indicators. The FTX screen provides a crosswalk between those three letter codes and the indicator it identifies. Once you have used MEDPROS for a while, you will have these memorized, but in the interim this table provides an easy access to the definition for each of them.



In the past few lessons, you have learned what medical readiness indicators MEDPROS measures, the three letter codes for each of them, and their definitions. There are several unit level medical readiness rosters available to tell you the medical readiness status of personnel in your unit. One of these rosters is the Unit/TF Medical Roster, which shows you each of the medical readiness indicators and the value assigned to that indicator from other automated systems or by your manual input. For indicators such as HIV Tests and Current Medical Assessments, the date of the last event appears on this roster. For Dental Readiness Classification, the numerical value of 1 through 4 will appear.

***<TAB> to UIC and type your unit identification code. Type or select the IMM and MED Profiles you want to measure against. <TAB> to the underscore to the left of the FTK option, type the letter "S" to select and press <ENTER>.***


*View Unit/TF Medical Roster (FTK)*

The Unit/TF Medical Roster appears with the name, rank, SSN, and UIC of each individual in the unit. This roster has three “sides”. You can view sides two and three by pressing the F11, page right key. You can return by pressing the F10, page left key. Note that the columns for HIV and CMA (if they are in your profile) show the dates of the last test/assessment. Also note that the DENTal field shows the Dental Readiness category (1-4) for each soldier. All other fields have Yes, No, or NA as their assigned values. No data has been entered or automatically fed into fields that are Blank, indicating they need to be populated on the soldier’s individual medical readiness record.

**NOTE: HIV, DNA, PANograph, and IMMunization data fields are automatically fed from other automated databases and cannot be updated by the MEDPROS user. For the Active Component, the DENTal category is also automatically updated from the Corporate Dental Application (CDA) utilized by the Active Army.**



The business rules you reviewed when learning how to create or update profiles (FTV) are used to assign a readiness rating of Green, Amber, or Red to each of the medical readiness indicators. Indicators that are rated “Red” indicate that a soldier is non-deployable. Currently, the only indicators that may appear as red and subsequently give the soldier an overall readiness of red are Pregnancy (PRG) and Medical NonDeployable (MND) Profiles. This is subject to change as the system matures. Amber ratings indicate a shortfall that may be required prior to deployment, but can normally be remedied in a short period of time (i.e. DNA or CMA). A Green rating indicates the soldier is fully “ready” for that specific indicator. This rating will appear when the specific requirement is met and up to date or if it is not applicable to that soldier (i.e. glasses & mask inserts). The Unit/TF Medical Readiness Status Roster provides MEDPROS users and Commanders with a quick snapshot of personnel in their unit and their rating for each of the medical readiness indicators in the profile selected and an overall unit rating.

Type or select the IMM and MED Profiles you want to measure against. <TAB> to Country and Operation Code and type in the appropriate codes for each. <TAB> to the underscore to the left of the FTL option, type the letter “S” and press <ENTER>.***


The Unit/TF Medical Readiness Status Roster shows the readiness rating for each medical readiness indicator in the Medical Profile selected on the previous screen. Overall ratings for each soldier are also shown for readiness (RD) and deployment (DP). The top portion of the screen shows a summary of how many soldiers are coded Green, Amber, and Red for readiness and deployment. Personnel who have no automated medical records (DNA, HIV, etc.) will have Xs across many of the fields on this screen. A total count of those with no medical records appears in the top right section above the readiness indicators. Once any manually entered field is updated on those records, the Xs will no longer appear. This roster may be printed by following procedures learned earlier.



When preparing a unit for deployment, MEDPROS provides the Unit/TF Medical Readiness Recap Roster to provide users with a recap of all shortfalls in each medical readiness category. When this roster appears, it will look similar to the previous rosters with the exception of the entries under the data fields.

On this roster, a field that has no entry indicates the soldier is Green or ready for that requirement. An amber (A) or red (R) rating indicates that a resource may be needed to make the soldier deployable for that requirement. A blank (B) entry indicates that the data field for that requirement has not been filled in (populated), so therefore a determination cannot be made on any resource requirement.

***<TAB> to UIC and type your unit identification code. Type or select the IMM and MED Profiles you want to measure against. <TAB> to Country and Operation Code and type in the appropriate codes for each. <TAB> to the underscore to the left of the FTN option, type the letter “S” and press <ENTER>.***





The Pre and Post Deployment information may also be done as a mass update. Complete the necessary fields for each.



Most soldiers in the Army are required some type of hearing protection. For the average soldiers, that may be a simple pair of earplugs that attach to their uniform pocket in a plastic case. For others, such as generator mechanics or drivers of vehicles with high decibel output, that hearing protection may be more specialized. In either case, typing a Y (Yes) in the Occupational Protection Hearing (OPH) field will indicate that the soldiers selected on the subsequent roster have the required hearing protection, whatever it may be.

***<TAB> to the underscore to the right of OPV, type the letter “Y” and press the <ENTER> key.***



The unit Medical Roster appears (FTK). To select the requirements individually, type an “S” on the underscores to the right that only apply to the individual, go to the Command Line, type the letter “U” and press the <ENTER> key to update their records. 





The specific immunizations required for the Eastern Europe Profile appear on the Individual Immunization Profile Status screen. If the soldier has received any of the immunizations and they have been posted in MEDPROS, the date of their last immunization will appear on this screen and the date they are due a booster will appear in the Date Due column. The “#” field shows the number (in a series) the soldier received last. The Status column indicates if the soldier is CP (initial series complete), AD (soldier is adequately protected, but has not received all of the initial immunizations in a series), or PA (partially protected; soldier has received at least one shot in the initial series, but has not received enough to be considered adequately protected). This is a “view only” screen. If you want to post immunizations a soldier has received, you can toggle to the FRK (Post Individual Shot Record) screen by pressing the F5 key.

Report #2 – Unit Individual Medical Requirement allows users to build a profile for one specific requirement (i.e. DNA) and build a list of all personnel who do not meet the standards outlined for that requirement.







One difference between each component's deployment profile and their readiness profile is the timeframe used as a measurement tool for HIV.

The Deployment Profile for each component (Active, Guard, Reserve) shows the HIV test requirement to be within 180 days of deployment. HIV test requirements for Readiness differ between Components – Active Army (which includes AGRs) is every two years, while the standard National Guard and Army Reserve readiness requirement is every five years.

Active, Guard, and Reserve Readiness Profiles differ in which medical readiness requirements are measured. The National Guard and Army Reserve require a Current Medical Assessment (CMA) each year where a physical is not performed. This is not a requirement for the Active Army.

Sickle Cell Screening is currently not a requirement on any Army Component's profiles, but is a requirement for the Navy and Air Force and is therefore included in the DoD Profile. This field appears on all individual medical readiness screens, but leaving it blank will not impact on an Army soldier's readiness rating.
